


Tech Brief Series

Software Overview

of liability options and managed care authorizations are tracked and can quickly be accessed by the staff. It is this Client centered approach that gives the software its unique ability to work as you work so that more time and energy can be devoted to Client services.

The diagram to the left shows an overview of some of the key modules. The registration of the client establishes the base record that provides the system with the link to all other activities. The Client Master File then links the Managed Care, Clinical, and Service History functions together for a holistic view of your client. The Service History then provides the required information to drive the Accounting (Accounts Receivable) and Reporting Modules. Additionally a complete General Ledger Module is available or the program can provide the needed links to existing legacy general ledgers. All external reporting requirements can be accurately fulfilled.

Other features include integrated links to industry standard applications for the desktop computer such as WordPerfect, the Microsoft Office Suite, and ODBC compliant programs such as SPSS. The program also supports all of its modules on both inexpensive terminals as well as standard desktop computers for a wide range of options that can meet your needs for a complete Client Management System.
